The International Investment Law Centre Cologne (IILCC) is pleased to announce a **call for contributions** for the new edition of the **Digest of International Investment Jurisprudence**. Join the editorial team as a Case Analyst and get your analysis published online.

## WHAT IS THE DIGEST OF INTERNATIONAL INVESTMENT JURISPRUDENCE?

The Digest of International Investment Jurisprudence provides a **collection of decisions rendered in investment treaty arbitration** in a systematically processed manner. It is the only online database of this format worldwide that is **freely accessible**, thus reaching a particularly wide audience and supporting scholars, students and practitioners in their work and studies. ## WHAT IS THE WORK OF A CASE ANALYST?

For each new edition of the Digest, its Editors and the Editorial Board compile a list of key arbitral decisions which shape the development of international investment law. The Editors assign decisions to Case Analysts, taking into account their individual preferences, e.g. their field of research, inasmuch as possible.

Case Analysts contribute to the Digest on a pro bono basis by adding new content to the online database. They commit themselves to analyse a certain number of decisions within a specific timeframe (for example 10 decisions within 12 months). For their work, they are trained and supported by the Editors. An on-site presence in Cologne is not required for this purpose.

- Working with an Editorial Board comprised of distinguished academics and legal practitioners in the field of international investment law,

## WHO CAN APPLY?

The IILCC recruits new Case Analysts from academia and legal practice. Applications from PhD candidates and young lawyers are particularly welcome. Candidates wishing to be added to the directory of Case Analysts must

- Be equipped with a university degree in law,
- Outline their scientific expertise or practical experience in international investment law,
- Be fluent in English.
