Dear PhD students,

You are conducting research in international investment law and would like to exchange views and get in touch with other doctoral students? If this is the case, the seminar organized by the International Investment Law Centre Cologne (IILCC) might be of interest to you.

This year, the seminar will take place on 6 July and - depending on the number of participants - on 7 July 2018 at the University of Cologne.

The format of the seminar provides that participants give a 15-minutes presentation on a freely chosen topic related to international investment law, which will be discussed afterwards. The presentation can be held in German or English. To facilitate the discussion, participants are asked to submit a short summary of their topic (approx. 1-2 pages) one week in advance. Doctoral students of the University of Cologne have the possibility to obtain a seminar certificate by submitting a written paper.

In addition, participants are welcome to attend the conference „[Protection of Foreign Investments in Europe – Perspectives & Solutions](#)“ which will be held on 5 July 2018. The event will inter alia focus on the consequences of the Achmea judgment recently rendered by the European Court of Justice. The detailed conference program will be available on our website soon.
